FUNERAL SERVICES HELD WED'SDAY FOR MRS. WILLIE JENSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. Willie Jensen were held from the Bethany Lutheran Church on Wednesday, March 26, with Pastor Noel Vold officiating. She passed away Sunday, March 23, at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital after a long illness.

She was united in marriage to Willie Jensen, June 14, 1922, and to this union five children were born. One infant child preceded her in death.
