PAUL PAULSEN RITES HELD WEDNESDAY AT BETHANY LUTH.

Funeral services for Paul C. Paulsen were held on Wednesday of this week from Bethany Lutheran Church, Viborg. Pallbearers were Ellwood Paulsen, Kermit Paulsen, Merlin Paulsen, Leonard Paulsen, Leon Madsen and Millage Madsen. Burial was in Rosehill Cemetery.

Paul C. Paulsen, son of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Paulsen, was born December 5, 1881, on their farm home near Irene. He passed away on Sunday, July 18, 1971, after a lingering illness, at the age of 90 years, 7 months and 18 days.

He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

He was a member of the IOOF and Rebecca Lodge.

He attended the University of South Dakota, homesteaded in the State of Wyoming, and had been engaged in farming south of Viborg until he entered the Good Samaritan Home at Centerville in 1962; moved to the Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home at Viborg, as one of the first residents when the home opened in 1970, and was a resident there at the time of his death.

He is survived by a brother-in-law, Niels J. Paulsen of Centerville, and several nieces and nephews.

His parents, four sisters, and one brother preceded him in death. Blessed be his memory.
