The funeral of Hans Henningsen took place at the East Swan Lake cemetery Sunday, March 19th. A great number of people gathered at the home and at the old Swan Lake Lutheran church to bring the bereaved their sympathy and to pay the last honor to the well known old man, who has lived in this community for many years. Rev. Th. N. Jersild officiating. His three sons and three son-in-laws were pall bearers.

Hans Henningsen was born in Tosted near Horsens, Denmark, May 2nd, 1838. In 1868 he was married to Christine Nielsen, and in their happy matrimony the Lord blessed them with 10 children of which 3 died while young, but 7, namely, Nels Henningsen, Hans Henningsen Jr., Miss sine Henningsen, Mrs. A. W. Green, Mrs. O. D. Flint, Mrs. Andrew Hansen and Alfred Henningsen are still living and together with their mother mourn the loss of their beloved husband and father. All of the children except Mrs. Green, who lives at Ruthton, Minn., are living in this community. Hans Henningsen came to this country in 1882 and bought a homestead 3 miles southwest of Viborg, and there he lived until his death March 17th. He was an esteemed and able man, who for years back was president of the East Swan Lake Lutheran church. Hans Henningsen was loved and will be missed in the home and the community.
