FUNERAL SERVICES HELD FRIDAY FOR MRS. C. K. CHRISTENSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. C. K. Christensen were held on Friday, Jan. 22, 1971, at 2 o'clock from the Spring Valley Lutheran Church. A prayer service was held at 8:00 o'clock on Jan. 21 at the Gaddis Funeral Home. Pastor Wallis N. Larson conducted the services. Mrs. Helen Holm and Mrs. Marilyn Sletten were the organists. Soloists were Rev. Vold, who sang "How Great Thou Art", and Mrs. Bennie Jensen, who sang "Face to Face" and "Nearer My God To Thee". The congregation sang "Jesus, Savior, Pilot Me" and "He Leadeth Me". Pallbearers were Leonard Sorensen, Earl Sorensen, Hartvig Hansen, George Graves, Martin Christensen and Arnold Larsen. Interment was in the churchyard cemetery with the Viborg Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. The Ladies Aid served coffee and lunch in the church parlors.

Madsine Madsen was born in Ryde Logn, Denmark, to Niels and Mette Madsen on Nov. 27, 1891. She departed this life on Jan. 19, 1971, at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg at the age of 79 years.

Mrs. Christensen was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith and after coming to this country she joined the Spring Valley Lutheran Church.

She was married to Chris K. Christensen at the Spring Valley Lutheran parsonage on Nov. 9, 1917, by Pastor T. N. Jersild.

Mrs. Christensen leaves to mourn her departure, seven children—five daughters: Ruth Christensen, Ann Hallberg and Doris Donahue, all of Denver, Pearl Dawson of Sioux Falls, and Shirley Korsmo of Minneapolis; and two sons: Alden and Kilmer Christensen of Viborg. Also 11 grandchildren, and several sons and daughters-in-law, and several nieces and nephews in Denmark. She was the last survivor of the 10 Madsen children.
