The funeral was held yes. terday from the Viborg Lutheran church and interment took place in the Swan Lake Lutheran cemetery. Rasmus Jorgensen was born Sept. 25th, 1838, in the village of Raarup by Horsens, Denmark, died June 1st, 1914, and reached the ripe age of 76 years, 8 months and 6 days. He was a veteran of the Danish-German war of 1863-64.

In the year of 1868 he married his now bereaved widow, Jacobine Johanne, born Hansen, and in 1892 he emigrated with his wife and children, with the exception of his oldest son, to America and located near Viborg, in which immediate vicinity he has resided ever since.

Besides his widow he leaves four sons and three daughters to mourn him, of which the oldest son, Sofus, is residing in Molde, Norway; Charley and Anton in Viborg; and Christian in Irene; and the daughters are: Mrs. C. T. S. Goodhope and Mrs. Pete Petersen, residing in Viborg, and Mrs. Arthur Olsen, Irene. All are well known in this community.
