Lorrain "L.E." Anderson was born March 19, 1930 at Viborg.

His parents were Leslie and Agnes (Hansen) Anderson.

He attended country school and graduated from Viborg High School in 1948. He went to Yankton College and then Augustana College where he received his BA Degree in teaching. He served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. L.E. Married Yvonne Larson on June 5, 1955. He received his Masters teaching degree from Brookings and Vermillion. He taught school in Clear Lake and then Axtell Park in Sioux Falls until 1972. He was a teacher and principal in Bancroft, NE until 1974, then at Corsica until 1977, and then at Tripp until 1980. L.E. and Yvonne moved to Viborg in 1980 where he was a teacher and principal until 1987. He was an elementary principal and teacher at Wakonda from 1988 to 1995. He retired in 1995,

but continued to substitute teach in Viborg, Wakonda, Parker, Irene, and Marion until 2001. L.E. had been an EMT with the Viborg Ambulance Service and a member of the Viborg American Legion, NEA, SDEA, and NRA. He served on his church council and on the Viborg School Board. He enjoyed hunting, fishing with his grandchildren, and spending time with his family and dogs at their Black Hills Cabin.

L.E. passed away on December 6, 2002 at Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg at the age of 72.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister Finis Pasco.

L.E. is survived by his wife Yvonne of Viborg; his children Karla and husband Paul Harms of Parker, Charles and wife Angie of Viborg, Julie Anderson and friend

Dave Luke on Viborg, and Kevin and wife Janis of Sturgis; six grandchildren Jamie and Jennifer Anderson of Viborg, Tiara Anderson of Viborg, Erin and Adam Harms of Parker, and Bradley Anderson of Sturgis; and many other relatives and friends.
